

High School Program

WSSD will open for all students to return with care and mandated precautions as allowed by the county. We will follow our County and State regulations during COVID-19 and incorporate guidance from the American Association of Pediatrics.

Physical Space and Class Grouping

High school grades will remain together as single class groups and will be assigned to their own classroom and outdoor spaces to allow for social distancing. These class Cohort-units will remain separated to minimize exposure. Separate outdoor areas are designated for each grade. Students will be taught by their seminar teacher and regular class teachers, who will rotate through the different spaces.

Curriculum and General Daily Plan

7:45-8:10 - Check-in

Students will be dropped off at the entrance gate where they will complete a health screening and put their phones in their Yondr pouches.

8:10-8:20 - Morning Circle

This will be held on the Colina pool parking lot

8:20-10:00 - Seminar/first morning class

Students will go to their class' designated classroom space

10:00-10:20 - Snack

Each grade will have a designated outdoor space

10:20-11:55 - 1st and 2nd periods

These will be held in each class' designated classroom space. Athletics and eurythmy will be held in outdoor spaces on the campus.

11:55-12:35 - Lunch

Each grade will have a designated outdoor space

- 12:35-3:00 3rd, 4th, and 5th periods
 - These will be held in each class' designated classroom space. Athletics and eurythmy will be held in outdoor spaces on the campus.

Exceptions/Notes:

Shared surfaces and equipment will be cleaned after each use.

Each class will have an early release day (2:45pm) - days TBD

For some classes and clubs, a 6th period once a week may be added to the schedule.

Drop-Off/Pick-Up

Students will be dropped off at the entrance gate where they will complete a health screening and put their phones in their Yondr pouches. Students who drive themselves will receive the health check and their Yondr pouches from their cars and then park in the upper parking lot before walking to the pool parking lot.

At pick-up, parents will enter the school drive and pick up their student(s) from their designated space on the campus. Parents may only enter the school building if they receive a health check first.

The North County shuttle will continue to pick-up and drop-off students from the train. Seating will be spaced for proper distancing and the daily health screening will be performed before students enter the shuttle. Masks must be worn on the shuttle.

Physical Health and Hygiene

The school holds the health of our community members at the center of all our planning. Strict adherence to the school's health and wellness policies will be maintained for the benefit of all. Please familiarize yourself with the daily health screening procedure, drop-off /pick-up procedures, school policies and expectations regarding sick children, teachers, and family members. Your first parent meeting will include a review of these policies and procedures.

Teachers will model frequent handwashing and support students in regular, thorough hand washing. High touch surfaces such as sink knobs, toilet handles, tables and door handles will be regularly cleaned following state and county regulations.

Masks/ Shields and Social Distancing

After great deliberation and research, the following decisions have been made in an effort to balance the developmental stage of the students with the health of the students and teachers.

Students, faculty, and staff will be required to wear masks and/or shields while indoors such as in classrooms and moving through hallways. When outside and socially distanced, masks or shields will not be required.

Social and Emotional Health and Integration into School

We recognize that during the school closure many students were not physically interacting with others outside their immediate family. We are working on developing ways to help students transition from home to school and to integrate more easily with their friends, teachers, and school day.

Remote Instruction for Students Remaining Home Due to Illness

If a student or student's family member develops COVID-19 symptoms and that student is under quarantine, Zoom links and Google Classrooms will be offered for Seminar, Humanities, Spanish, and

Math for the duration of the quarantine. For athletics, eurythmy, and art classes, individualized plans will be implemented case-by-case as needed.

Remote Instruction during School Closure

In the event that the high school campus closes, instruction will continue via Zoom and Google Classrooms. Emphasis will be placed on creating a healthy and manageable schedule with minimal screen time.
